El pasado continuo se utiliza para acciones que estaban pasando en un momento específico en el pasado. Se forma con el verbo "was o were " y el verbo+ing.
 Form (Forma)

Sujeto	Auxiliar (to be)	Verb+ing
I, he, she, it	was	talking, eating, learning, doing, going...
you, we, they	were	talking, eating, learning, doing, going...

Affirmative Sentences (Frases afirmativas)

Sujeto + verbo auxiliar (to be) + verbo+ing.

I was talking. (Estaba hablando.)

Negative Sentences (Frases negativas)

Sujeto + verbo auxiliar (to be) + "not" + verbo+ing

I was not [wasn't] talking.(No estaba hablando.)

Interrogative Sentences (Frases interrogativas)

Verbo auxiliar (to be) + sujeto + verbo+ing?

Were you talking?(¿Estabas hablando?)
